- The Norfolk & Western Class J No. 611 locomotive was built on May 29, 1950, at the N&W's East End Shops in Roanoke, Virginia. It was one of 14 Class J 4-8-4 locomotives built by Norfolk & Western between 1941 and 1950. The 611 is now a part of the Virginia Museum of Transportation (VMT) and has been restored twice, operating on excursions and as a traveling exhibit.
